## ADMISSION PROCESS

The admission process of Arifa Institute of Technology follows a structured procedure governed by both government regulations and institutional policies. Below is a detailed breakdown of the process.

### 1. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for admission into Arifa Institute of Technology, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ **Educational Qualification:** Candidates must have passed the **Higher Secondary Examination (HSC / 10+2)** or an equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics as core subjects.
- ✓ **Minimum Marks Requirement:**
- ✓ **General Category:** Minimum **45%** aggregate in PCM (Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics).
- ✓ **SC/ST/OBC Candidates:** Minimum **40%** aggregate in PCM (as per Tamil Nadu government norms).
- ✓ **Age Limit:** There is no upper age limit, but candidates must have completed **17 years of age** at the time of admission.

### 2. Admission through Government Quota (TNEA)

A significant portion of seats i.e., 65% of total sanctioned intake is filled through the **Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions (TNEA)**, conducted by DOTE.

### Steps in the TNEA Admission Process:

1. **Online Registration:** Candidates must register on the **TNEA official website** by filling out personal and academic details.
2. **Application Submission:** Required documents, including x mark sheets, community certificates (if applicable), and nativity certificates, must be uploaded.
3. **Rank List Publication:** Anna University releases a **rank list** based on **+2marks** (no entrance exam for TNEA).
4. **Counseling Process:** Candidates are called for **online counseling** based on their ranks, where they can choose their preferred colleges and branches.
5. **Seat Allotment:** Based on merit and choices, candidates are allotted seats.
6. **Final Admission:** Candidates must report to the allotted college, verify documents, and pay the fees to confirm admission.

### 3. Admission through Management Quota


Private engineering colleges in Tamil Nadu are allowed to admit students under the **Management Quota (Direct Admission)**, which usually accounts for **35-50%** of the total seats.

#### Management Quota Admission Process:

1. **Application Form Submission:** Students can apply directly to the college through online or offline application forms.
2. **Merit-Based Selection:** Some reputed private colleges conduct entrance tests or personal interviews.
3. **Seat Confirmation:** Admission is granted based on academic performance and availability of seats.
4. **Fee Payment:** Students must pay the prescribed tuition fees and submit necessary documents for verification.

### 4. Admission through Consortium of Private Colleges

Apart from TNEA and direct admissions, some **self-financing engineering colleges** admit students through a consortium process. The **Consortium of Self-Financing Professional, Arts, and Science Colleges in Tamil Nadu** conducts its own admission procedure.

### Steps in Consortium Admission Process:

- Students must apply through the consortium's official website or designated admission centers.
- Merit lists are prepared based on **10 +2marks** or **entrance tests** conducted by the consortium.
- Shortlisted candidates attend **counseling sessions** to choose their preferred colleges and courses.

### 5. Lateral Entry Admissions (Diploma Holders)

Diploma holders seeking direct admission into the **second year (3rd semester)** of **B.E./B.Tech** programs can apply through the **Direct Second Year Admission (Lateral Entry) Scheme**.

- Admissions for **government quota** are handled through **TNDTE (Tamil Nadu Directorate of Technical Education)** counseling.
- **Management quota** seats can be applied for directly at private colleges.

### 6. Admission for NRI & Foreign Students

Private engineering colleges in Tamil Nadu also offer admissions under the **NRI (Non- Resident Indian) quota** and **foreign student category**.

- NRI candidates must submit proof of NRI status, along with academic records.
- Admissions are based on 12<sup>th</sup> standard marks, and some institutions conduct interviews.

- Transfer Certificate(TC)
- Income Certificate(for scholarships)
- First graduate certificate(if applicable)
- Community Certificate(for reserved categories)
- Nativity Certificate(if applicable)
- Passport-sized Photographs
- Aadhar Card

- Private Scholarships from colleges and NGOs.
- Education Loans from banks with college support.
